The Regular Session of 1901-1902, being the 31st Consecutive Winter Session, will begin on Wednesday, the 25th day of September next, and will continue for eight months. The opening lecture will be delivered by Professor Sheard at 4 o'clock p.m. on that day. The daily work of the College begins at 9 o'clock a.m. on the following day. It is hoped that, in view of their own interests, students will as far as practicable, be present at the opening lecture, so as to lose none of the early teachings in the several branches.

The Treasurer and other members of the Faculty will be in attendance at the College on Wednesday, September 18th, 1901, and the following days, up to the date of the opening of the session, from 10 a.m. to 12 noon, and from 2 till 4 p.m., to register the names of intending students, and to give such information regarding Lectures, etc., as may be required.
