FALSE BOTTOMS IN MOVING VANS YIELD TREASURE

Ingenious Scheme to Carry Liquor from Montreal is Revealed.

Windsor, Aug. 14.—Concealed from view in cleverly constructed false bottoms on two large covered furniture vans, Scotch whiskey and cognac worth \$7,000 was discovered and confiscated by Provincial police at Sunnyside, a resort on the river front, seven miles below Windsor.

Lee Burke and his brother, William Burke, drivers of the vehicles, were arrested. They face three charges: transporting liquor on a public highway in Ontario, having liquor in a place other than private dwellings, and transporting liquor from one province to another.

When provincial men arrived at Sunnyside the two vans, piled high with furniture, were just pulling in, after a four-day direct run from Montreal. Casual inspection of the vehicles revealed nothing.

Then Inspector Putnam and his men took off their coats and pitched out the furniture. It was covered with a thick coating of dust, and apparently had not been touched in some time.

When the last article had been removed, with no sign of any liquor, the rum-hunters were non-plussed, believing they had trailed along wrong tracks. Examination of the bottoms of the vans, however, showed them to be of unusual thickness. Further inspection revealed strongly built false bottoms. In each van were 320 bottles of choice brands of "Scotch." There was a separate compartment for each bottle of precious fluid, and this was carefully padded to prevent rambling or breakage.
