

Railway Freight Rates.

Winnipeg, March 17—Criticism of the Manitoba government over its alleged neglect to enfore its right to control over railway freight rates on the Canadian National Railway in Manitoba and to the head of the lakes was answered in the legislature yesterday by Hon. Thomas Johnson, attorney general

J. Thaigh, Conservative leader, moved a resolution consuring the administration in this connection.

Mr. Johnson contended that "validating legislation" enacted in the federal parliament in 1901, supposed to affirm the rights given the province in their agreement with the Canadian National Railway signed early in the same year, was in reality "invalidating" legislation.

Reservations were made, he said, which took away control over rates from the provincial authorities, and because of them, the present government of Manitoba had been unable to reap the full benefit to which it was entitled to under the agreement.

Mr. Johnson declared that Hon. Robert Rogers was at the bottom of the present "agitation" against the government in this matter.

The attorney-general said it was "quite within range of possibility" that the dominion government "might be called upon to make good any loss that the province may have suffered in consequence of their interference with our contractual right."


