ships under which they were suffering in that unhappy country, and was successful, after tireless search in locating them. Many other immigrants also accompanied the party.

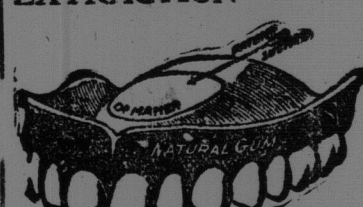
TRAVEL ON PASS; GIVE YOUR SEAT UP TO PAYING PASSENGER.

IN PARLIAMENT

Question of Ban on Immigration While There is So Much Unemployment.

Ottawa, March 31.—(Canadian Press)

Yesterday in the House of Commons, suspension of all immigration "until a nominal condition of affairs is established," was moved by H. Deslauriers, St. Mary's, Montreal, and seconded by Edmond Proulx of Prescott. Both speakers opposed admitting artisans while unemployment continued throughout Canada.

W. K. Baldwin of Standstead, declared that there never was a period during which it was more difficult to secure farm labor. He criticized proposals for an eight hour day for farm laborers. Labor, he said, must produce more and work more cheaply.

The resolution was withdrawn on a promise by Hon. J. A. Calder, minister of immigration, that he would make a statement when the immigration department estimates were before the house.

In the senate, Hon. D. C. David moved for correspondence between the imperial and Canadian governments, dealing with Canada's representation in the British parliament or in any council, for empire, contribution to empire wars and to establishment of a British or Canadian navy.

Hon. G. D. Robertson said the government did not object to tabling the correspondence, but there might be some of it which could not, in the public interest, be brought down.

Amendments to the post office act were considered in committee and progress reported.

Today the commons will take up the estimates of the labor, interior and trade and commerce departments and will also proceed with the Lake of the Woods control bill. The senate will meet at 3 p. m.

ROGERS SAYS POLITICAL REPORTS NEWS TO HIM

Winnipeg, March 31.—"This is the first I have heard of it," said Hon. Robert Rogers to the Canadian Press when his attention was called to a report from Montreal that he might be a candidate for the house of commons to succeed Sir Herbert Ames. "It is news to me," he said.
