Society of Toronto,  
FOR 1872.

"The Committee of Management beg leave to present the usual Annual Report, with its accompanying financial statements.

The total amount of receipts during the year ending the 31st December, 1872, inclusive of the balance of \$153.86 in hand at the date of last report is \$2,179.17.

The total disbursements amount to \$1,897.36, leaving a balance in the hands of the Treasurer, amounting to \$281.81.

APPLICATIONS FOR RELIEF, ETC.

During the past year, eleven hundred and eighty-three applications for relief, in various forms have been made. Of this number eight hundred and sixty-three families and individuals representing about two thousand, two hundred persons, and averaging two and one-half persons to a family, have been relieved with donations, in kind, bread and meat, the value of which is (\$501.76) five hundred and one dollars and seventy-six cents. One hundred and forty families and individuals have been relieved with donations in money; seventy families and individuals with donations in money and kind; and eighty-nine with passes over the different lines of railway.
