After devotional exercises, the minutes of the preceding Sederunt were read and approved.

Mr. Ormiston licensed.

The Prophytery of Toronto reported that since the last meeting of Synod they had sustained trials for License, appointed to Mr. Wm. Ormiston, and that on the 1st August last, he was licensed to preach the gospel in connexion with this Synod.
