

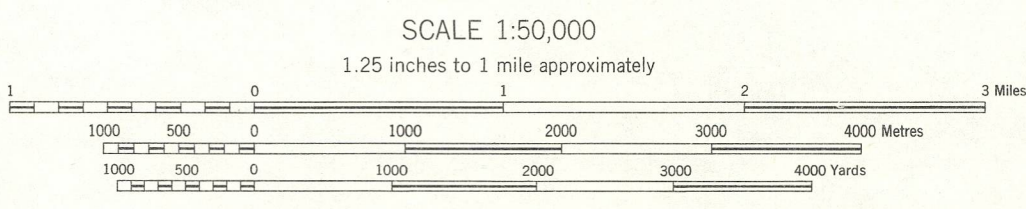

Annual magnetic change 9' easterly

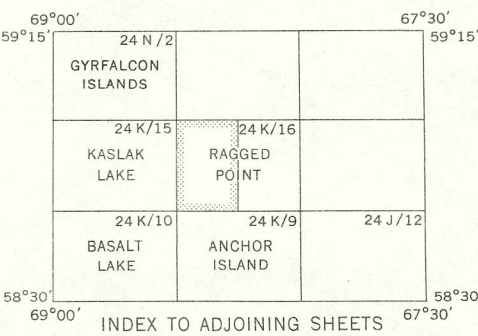
