

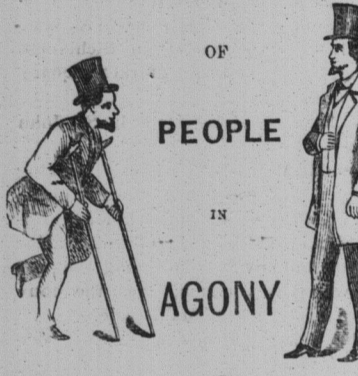

Solomon in Modern Life. Sometimes a good rule does not work. Two women came before Alderman Dobbs in our village the other day to settle a dispute about a child.

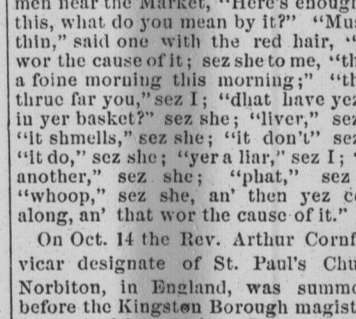

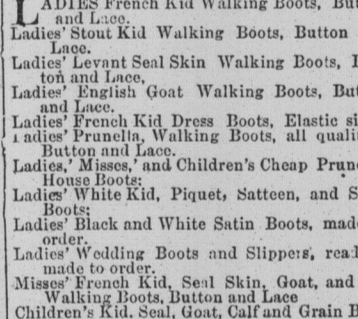
