TO THE COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT FOR THE YEAR 1893.

The Sub-Committee of Charity beg to submit their statement of expenditure for the past year. The whole amount paid out has been \$391.61, including the usual Xmas dinner to 25 English families; the following being the disbursements in detail:
