2. Wherever in The Railway Act the expression "railway" Railway to occurs, it shall, unless the context otherwise requires, and in mean "canal." so far as it applies to the provisions of this Act, or to the Company, mean the "canal" "or other works" hereby 5 authorized to be constructed; and in any section of The Railway Act relating to the collection of tolls, where the expressions "passengers" and "goods," or either of them, occur, such "Goods," expressions shall be held to include any vessel passing through "vessel," the canal, whether laden or otherwise.

Any Act hereafter passed for the purpose of controlling Power of railway companies incorporated by or subject to Parliament, as to future as to the issuing of stock or bonds, and as to rates or tolls and legislation. 15 the regulation thereof, and as to running powers over or other rights in connection with the railway of any company by any other company, and the exercise of powers conferred upon railway companies, shall apply to the Company from the time such Act goes into effect; but this section shall not be con-20 strued to imply that such Act would not apply to the Company without the enactment of this section.
