An Act to extend the provisions of the eighteenth section of the Railway Clauses Consolidation Act to the Act incorporating the Peterborough and Port Hope Railway Company.

[10th November, 1852.]

HEREAS the Municipal Councils of the Town of Port Preamble. Hope and the Townships of Hope and Cavan, in the County of Durham, and of the Township of South Monaghan, have by their petitions set forth that they are desirous of subscribing for shares in the stock of the Peterborough and Port Hope Railway Company, under the provisions of the eighteenth Section of The Railway Clauses Consolidation Act; but that they have been advised that the provisions of the said Section do not extend to the said company, inasmuch as the same was incorporated before the passing of The Railway Clauses Consolidation Act aforesaid, and have prayed that the said provisions and certain other provisions of the said Act may be extended to the company and the railway to be made by them; And whereas it is expedient to extend the provisions aforesaid to the said company:
