on producing whereof, Commillioners of the Treafury to pay the Reward.

Certificates thall be produced to the Lord Digh Treasurer. or any Three or more of the Commissioners of the Crealury for the Time being, and the faid Sum of Twenty thousand Pounds, and the said Sum of Five thousand Pounds, or the one or the other, as the Case may be. thall be respectively paid to such Person or Persons as are named in the faid Certificate of Certificates respectively. his. her, or their Erecutors, Administrators, or Assour, out of any the Aids or Supplies which thall be arented in Parliament to his Wajelty, his heirs, or Succes fors, after the faid Discovery of the said Porthern Pac face into the Pacific Ocean, and the faid Approach to within Dne Degree of the Worthern Pole, or the one or the other, as the Case may be, shall be made, effectuated, and vioved, and the laid Certificate produced as aforefaid.

All Claims to the Rewards to be made within Six Months after Arrival at any Port in Great Britain or Ireland. Provided always, and be it further enacted by the Austhority aforesaid. That the respective Claim of Claims on behalf of any Ship or Ships, Uellel or Aestels, unto the Rewards given by this Act, or either of them, that he made respectively, and entered with, or he by Letter signified to, the Secretary of the Lord High Admiral, or Airls Commissioner for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain for the Time being, at the Admiralty Office in London, within Six Months from the Time that such Ship or Aestels, Ships or Aestels, that have arrived at any Port of Great Britain or Ireland, otherwise the respective Claimant or Claimants that not be intitled to receive, nor thall receive, either of the faid Rewards; any Thing in this Act contained to the constrary notwithstanding.

Proviso.

Provided also, and he it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That if the said Rewards, or either of them, shall be claimed by and adjudged to the Commanister of Commanders, Officers and Seamen of any Ship or Iestel, Ships or Iestels, belonging to his Waishy, the same shall be disposed in favour of, and distributed among such Commander or Commanders, Officers and Seamen, in such Proportions as shall be directed by his Waishy in Council, and in no other Wanner.
