

Annæ Reginæ.

An Act for the Encouragement of the Trade to America.



DR Advancement of the Trade of Her Pajessies Kingdom of Great Britain, to and in the several Parts of America, for the further Encouragement of Her Pajessies Ships, and Private Ships of War, the Annoying and Diminishing the Wealth and Power of Her Majessies Enemies in those Parts, and for the Encrease of Shipping and of Seamen sor these and other Services; Be it Enased by the Ducens most Ercelstent Majessies

lent Haselly, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Comporal, and Commons in this present Parliament Assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That all Prize-Offices in any Port or Place in America be and are hereby Suppressed and Taken away, to all intents and purposes whatsoever, from and after the Four and twentieth Day of June, One thousand seven hundred and eight.

And for the better Encouragement also of such Ships and Aeffels of War, which are or shall be in Her Wajesties Pay or Service, Be it further Enaded by the Authority aforesaid, That the Flag-Officers, Commanders, and other Officers and Seamen of every such Ship or Uesel of War, shall have the sole Interest and Property of and in all and every Ship, Aeffel, Soods and Perchandize they shall Take in any Part of America (being first Adjudged Lawsul Prize in any of Her Wajesties Courts of Admiralty, and subject to the Customs and Duties payable to her Wajesty, as if the same had been such Imported to any Part of Great Britain, and from thence Exported, so and in respect of all such Soods and Verchandize) to be divided in such Proportions, and after such manner, as her Wajesty, her heirs and Successors shall think sit to Order and Direa.
