

I *A. B.* do swear, That I had not, between Oath.
 any Place or Employment of Profit, Civil or Military,
 under His Majesty, besides such Compensation as shall have
 been or may be made to me as a Commissioner for enquir-
 ing into the Losses and Services of all such Persons who
 have suffered in their Rights, Properties, and Professions,
 during the late unhappy Dissentions in *America*, in Con-
 sequence of their Loyalty to His Majesty, and Attachment
 to the *British* Government.

And the taking the said Oath shall be sufficient to intitle
 such Person to receive his half Pay, without taking any
 other Oath; any Law, Usage, or Custom, to the con-
 trary thereof notwithstanding.

XIV. And be it further enacted by the Authority afore-
 said, That in case of a Vacancy or Vacancies, by Death
 or Resignation, of any One or more of the said Commis-
 sioners, during the Recess of Parliament, it shall and
 may be lawful for His Majesty to nominate and appoint
 such Person or Persons as he may think proper to supply
 such Vacancy or Vacancies; and that every Person, so
 nominated and appointed, shall be held and considered to
 be invested with all the same Powers as are delegated to
 the Commissioners appointed by this Act.

In case of the
 Death. &c. of
 a Commis-
 sioner during
 the Recess of
 Parliament,
 His Majesty
 may appoint
 another.

XV. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall
 continue in Force for One Year, from the Fifteenth Day
 of July One thousand seven hundred and eighty-seven,
 and no longer.
