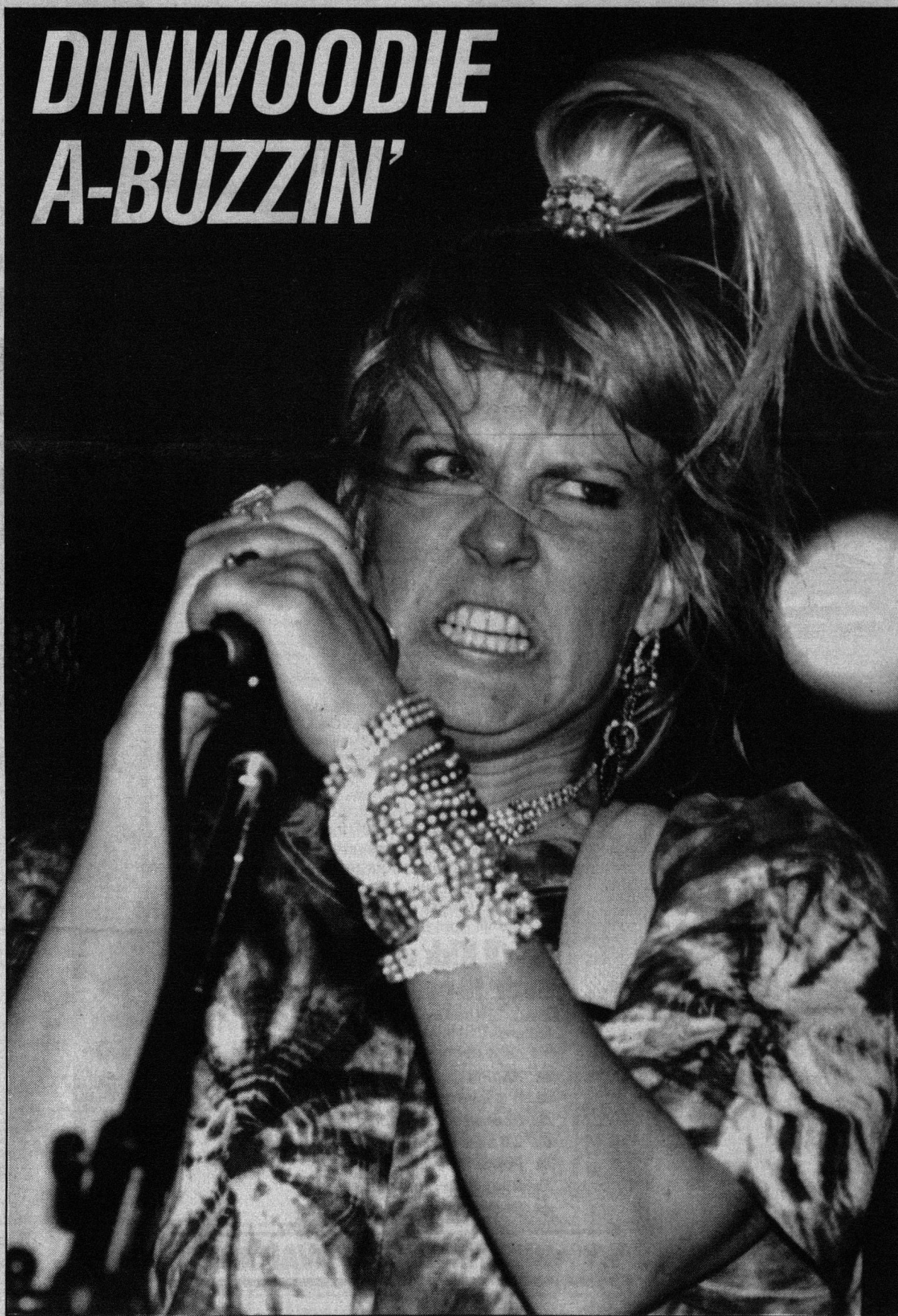

## DINWOODIE A-BUZZIN'



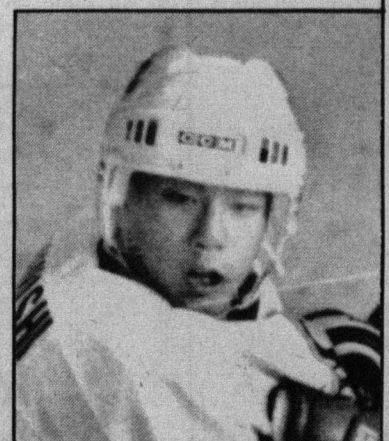
