

Taking McVardons best line, we find that it would cut off the entire supply of water for the Distillery & one third of the Dam, and a creek which forms about one third of the supply of water for the Mill.

McVardons North line it will be seen is nearly all covered with water and the Pond in Clarence Street is several feet deep.

The Blocks on the East side of Clarence Street and North side of Darling Street included within Mr Millers lines have never been laid out into lots and are not fit for Village lots, being principally Cedar Swamp, Mill Pond and low land.
