" "	3-3-41		F/O Gilbert arrived from No. 1 Training Command to see the A.O. re Secret and Confidential Publications. F/L Carling-Kelly arrived 2150 hours by rail as President, Court of Inquiry on Harvard #2622.	
" "	4-3-41		Flying washed out at 1800 hours. Field very soft.	
" "	5-3-41		Flying washed out at 1200 hours field soft, and was being badly cut up by aircraft taxiing. F/L H. de M. Molson left via Lysander (type of a/c) for London, approximately 1045 hours.	
" "	6-3-41		Clear bright day - C A V U. F/O L. J. Bishop of No. 1 Training Command arrived 0930 hours re Fire Fighting Equipment.	
" "	7-3-41		F/O Lachance from No. 1 Training Command on Messing.	
" "	8-3-41		Harvard 2813 (F/L Phillips--No. 2 Squadron) landed at Alliston Aerodrome with undercarriage retracted.
