OPPOSE VIGOROUSLY SECTION FOUR OF GRAHAM BILL EIGHTEEN ONE PRECLUDING EASTERN MILLERS AND CONSUMERS TO RECEIVE ILLEGAL FREIGHT CHARGES ERRONEOUSLY PUBLISHED AND COLLECTED BY RAILWAYS STOP ANSWER TO QUESTION THREE SUBMITTED TO SUPREME COURT INCORPORATED IN PRIVY COUNCIL ORDER ALLOW CROWNEST RATES GRAIN AND FLOUR FROM WESTERN POINTS TO ALL POINTS EAST OF FORTWILLIAM NAMELY TWENTY CENTS TO MONTREAL OR TORONTO INSTEAD OF THIRTY SEVEN AND HALF AS NOW CHARGED STOP PROTECT COUNTRY EAST OF FORTWILLIAM BY DEFEATING SECTION FOUR OF BILL WHICH EVIDENTLY CROWDED IN BILL PROTECTING RAILWAYS ON EXPENSE OF PUBLIC STOP IF CROWNEST RATES ON GRAIN AND FLOUR NOT TO BE ABROGATED AGREEMENT SHOULD APPLY IN IT'S ENTIRETY ACCORDING TO SUPREME COURT DECISION AND NOT ONLY WEST OF FORTWILLIAM STOP GRAHAM INTENTIONS TO INTRODUCE RETROACTIVE LEGISLATION NOT MENTIONED IN ORDER IN COUNCIL.
