Notes have already been communicated press. New fact is that in accordance with British request, they have been officially communicated all States Members Co-ordination Committee.

League's monthly bulletin statistics February just issued gives, besides usual tables, information concerning movement world trade in and production of iron, steel, zinc, coal, petroleum, and world stocks raw materials between 1929 and 1935. Shows also that both gold value and total amount of world trade were higher in 1935 than in 1934. World production iron, steel, zinc, coal, lignite, petroleum, 1935, higher than 1934. General index world stocks raw materials end of 1935 only twenty-five per cent higher than June, 1929, whereas towards middle 1934 it was about fifty per cent higher.
