Sir,-

With reference to Mr. Bray's visit to Deseronto in June last in connection with the right of way of the Bay of Quinte Railway in the Tyendinaga Indian reserve, I beg to state that action has been delayed on account of the failure of Rev. A.H. Creegan to carry out the proposal then made to have the boundaries of the Church property definitely defined.

If this work were done, the exact line between Lot 35 and the Church lot would be known. As however the area taken would practically be not affected, and as it is desirable to close the payment for the right of way on lot 35, I have to ask you to be good enough to file as soon as you reasonably can a plan showing the right of way finally decided upon, that is to say ^{wide} 66 feet across the property of the late Peter Green, and 99 feet wide across the Church property. The said 99 feet is to be 66 feet to the south of the centre line, and 33 feet to the north of it.

The plan, when received, will be sent to the Department of Railways and Canals for the certificate of
