Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 5th instant, reporting the application of George Bradley for permission to remove about a thousand feet of pine lumber from the reserve for use in building houses in Hagersville, I have to inform you that permission may be given if the consent of the band is obtained and that dues shall be paid at tariff rate under sworn returns.

In regard to your letter of the 16th of April, submitting the recommendation of Council in regard to dues on timber on Monica Jamieson's location, the Department approves the recommendation and a free permit may be given him if you have not issued it yet.
