Sir,-

The Department has received the account rendered at \$25.00 which you submitted recently in favor of Mr. Arthur Bois for fire wood furnished Indians of Seven Islands during July, August and September. An explanation is required as to why it was thought necessary to furnish wood during the summer season. It is considered that while the weather was fine, the Indians should have been able to gather sufficient fuel to meet their requirements. I have also to point out that apparently no authority was granted for the purchase.
