Sir,-


I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 8th instant, enclosing an amended return for the December quarter of the Pile Hills Boarding School.

The Department had already paid the grant for this school on an average attendance of 62.24 and the grant amounted to \$1,867.20.

It is noted that on the amended return no grant is requested for pupils Nos. 081 and 101 who were in hospital during the full quarter, and, therefore, no grant should have been paid for them.

A deduction of \$60.00, being the grant allowed for these two pupils will be made from the March quarter grant.
