46. The R.C.N. Medical Research Unit is continuing its lab work and experiments on the R.C.N. seasick pills, as well as making extensive sea trials on the value of protective clothing, a complete report of which has not yet been received.
47. The English Language School in H.M.C.S. "PREVOIST", established for the purpose of assisting those French Canadian Ratings requiring special instruction in English, commenced operations in October.
48. The recently initiated programme of discussion groups throughout the Service was considerably enlarged, and on Tuesday evenings co-ordinated with the C.B.C. broadcast series "Citizens Forum".
49. During the Quarter ending 31st December, 1943, the four National Organizations were all located overseas as follows:

- (a) Y.M.C.A. - to provide recreational facilities and amenities for H.M.C.S. "Niobe" and Canadian Naval Ships in the Clyde area.
- (b) K. of C. - to supply recreational facilities and amenities to Canadian Naval personnel in combined operations and coastal forces operating around the U.K.
- (c) Canadian Legion - to supply recreational facilities and amenities to H.M.C. Ships commissioning and operating in waters of the U.K.
- (d) Salvation Army - to supply recreational facilities and amenities to Canadian Naval personnel located in Londonderry, Northern Ireland.

50. Supervisors have been appointed by each Organization and are now putting in full time to supply recreational facilities and amenities in their various territories. The K. of C. were the last to appoint a supervisor due to the fact that the approval of the Order-in-Council for overseas supervisors was delayed.

51. Wren Establishments have been serviced consistently by the various Organizations. In the case of Establishments that are composed chiefly of Wren personnel, Organization female supervisors have been appointed to assist in providing recreational facilities and amenities. Additional furnishings and sports equipment have been supplied where required.
