

- A. I have been with this Coy slightly over a month and a half, previous to that I was in the 1st Can Air Survey Coy.
- Q. How long with them?
- A. With them since August the 15th 1944, till joining this Coy approximately the 1st of May, sir.
- Q. Did you have any other civilian or military experience as a draughtsman?
- A. In civilian life I was a draughtsman, I took up training 3 years in the Technical School and in the army, sir, that is all I have ever done, I have taken numerous courses in the army, sir, all drafting.
- Q. Is the plan, the floor plan Exhibit "J" the floor plan of the house on Exhibit "I", which you indicated by the letter "A"?
- A. Yes sir
- Q. Is the address of that house Nieuweg 86, Haaldwijk?
- A. That is the address I had sir, that is the address I had written down sir.
- Q. I didn't ask you that, I asked you if that was the address of the house depicted in the plan which you made and which are in evidence in Exhibits "I" and "J". Are they or are they not?
- A. Yes sir.
