## RE-EXAMINED BY THE PROSECUTOR

Q.43 When was it first mentioned?

A. 43 It came to me between 10 and 11 o'clock in the morning from Capt

Fuller over the phone.

And was it a request for him personally or a request for both of them? A. 1411 A.44 He mentioned that Capt Lockhart was going to spend Xmas at Winchester and he said that if he could go as far as Winchester with Capt Lockhart he could then go to Brighton to his own home by train.

Q.45 Did you take it in the nature of a joint request or an individual

request?

A. 45 As a joint request.

Q. 46 Subsequently when you discussed this with Capt Fuller was the conversation such to make you believe that it was for Capt Fuller personally or whether it was a joint veh between them?

A. 46 At no time did I have any idea other than that it was a joint veh to Winchester.

Q.46 When was the next time you saw Capt Fuller or Capt Lockhart or both ref this trip?

I saw them both in the Mess at noon, roughly between 12 and 1230, and spoke to them both at that time.

Did you speak to them again later? Yes I spoke to both of them. I was talking to Capt Lockhart between A. 47 roughly 1330 and 1345 over the phone on other business, and he was in his office, and I remarked "Aren't you going to Winchester".

Q.48 Sufficient to say you spoke to both of them?

A.48 Yes, Capt Lockhart between 1330 and 1400 and Capt Fuller about 1400

in my office.

## BY THE COURT

Q.49 In your earlier evidence you implied very definitely that no ref was made to Brighton and now you have just said that if he could get to Winchester he would proceed on to Brighton by train?

He told me he would proceed by train if he got to Winchester by car. 4.49

Brighton was discussed?

Q. 50 A. 50 In that respect, yes.

## BY THE J.A.

further

Q.51 You spoke of a pass/conversation with Capt Fuller at lunch time in

the Mess, who was present at that second conversation?

I couldn't say who was present, there was a good number of us around the bar, approx 18 or 20. A. 51

Q. 52 No one else took part in the conversation?

A. 52 Not that I can remember.

Q. 53 A. 53 Who was present when he came to your office at 1400 hrs? No one else at that time. The driver came in but went out again to his car at once. I was alone.

Did you or did you not give permission for the veh to go to Brighton? I did NOT give permission for the veh to go to Brighton.

## BY THE PRESIDENT:

You had no right to authorize a veh to go to Brighton? A. 55 That is correct.
