

The Arena

One of the largest indoor amusement places on the continent; seating capacity 6,700. Floor space, 80 x 200 feet, which in winter is used for ice skating and hockey matches. When used for concert purposes this space will seat 2000 people. In connection with the Arena there is an artificial ice plant with a capacity of 60 tons every 24 hours. Cost of construction of Arena, \$500,000.

Hanlan's Point Stadium

The only one of its kind in Canada. Built of cement and concrete; fireproof; seating capacity 10,000. The home of the Toronto Ball Club of the International League and the Tecumseh Lacrosse Club of the Big 4" Association.

Hanlan's Point, just across the bay from Toronto, was the birthplace of Edward Hanlan, the world's greatest oarsman. Twelve ferry steamers are used in the passenger service. The Ferry Company, Hanlan's Point and the Stadium are under the management of Mr. Laurence Solman.
