## RUPTURE.

Sometimes after a severe strain a tumour Ruptures-suddenly appears in the groin, and not unfrequently extends into the scrotum. Whenever this occurs, place the patient on his back in a recumbent position, with the limbs flexed; then place the hand on the tumour, and press gently obliquely upward and outwards. When it is reduced keep it in position until you find a surgeon. When, however, it is not easily returned, do not use violence, but make applications of cold water until the services of a surgeon can be obtained.

## NOTIFY SURGEON.

Whenever an accident occurs on the line, the conductor must immediately telegraph the surgeon surgeon in whose charge the injured person is to be placed, in order that time may be given to prepare for the reception of the patient.

## TRAMPS INJURED.

In cases of injury inflicted by trains upon intoxicated persons on the track, tramps steal-tramps. ing rides, etc., where the employees of the road are in no way to blame, the injured persons must, of course, be carried to a station where humane and proper treatment can be
