The faid amendment was read and is as follows:

RESOLVED, That this House doth concur in the said amendments

ORDERED, That Mr. Coffin and Mr. Taschereau do carry back the Bill to the Legislative Council and inform them, that this House hath agreed to their amendment.

The House being informed that the Clerk of the Crown in Chancery attended at the door, he was admitted, and delivered in at the Bar the Writ of Election for the County of Effingham, with sundry Documents thereunto annexed, pursuant to the orders of the House.

Ordered, That the faid writ and the feveral Papers accompanying the fame, be translated into French.

Mr. Craigie from the Committee appointed to enquire into the prefent state of the culture of Hemp in this Province, Reported that the Committee had taken into consideration the most effectual means for encouraging and extending the further culture of that article of Agriculture and Commerce, and had directed him to report their proceedings and opinion thereupon to the House: and he read the report in his place, and afterwards delivered the same, in at the table, where it was read by the Clerk,—and the same is as follows:

The Committee having affembled from time to time between the 26th January and 23d February inclusive, during which they examined divers Persons and Documents on the Subject of Reference, and having duly deliberated upon and maturely weighted the same, finally came to the following Resolutions, viz:
