A Bill to amend an Act passed in the thirty sixth year of his present Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for making, repairing and altering the highways and bridges within this Province, and for other purposes," and to provide more effectually for repairing and keeping in good order, the streets, roads and bridges in Saint John's and St. Rock's suburbs, was, according to order, read a second time.

RESOLVED, that the faid Bill be referred to a special Committee of seven Members, with power to send for persons and papers.
