Progress Made in the Development of the Various Mines of the Camp-War Eagle Company Said to Be After the Mugwump.

The announcement of the looked for arrival on April 12, of Hon. C. H. Mac- tion officials. kintosh, W. G. Carlyle and D. J. Rumor has connected the operations of the Gooderham-Blackstock syndicate with the acquisition of the Mugwump claim, adjoining the Pilgrim, and the Iron Mask. It is said that an option on 400,000 shares was taken up last week, and that the War Eagle people were the purchasers. The company was organ-ized in the summer of '96 and the stock has been quoted as high as 15 cemts, but has gone begging lately at 2 and 3 cents.
