WATER WORKS NOTICE! HOURS FOR SPRINKLING LAWNs No person or persons shall be allowed to sprinkle, or use in any manner whatsoever, the water supplied by the Board of Water Commissioners upon Lawns, Gardens, Yards or grounds of any description, except between the hours of six and eight-thirty o'clock p.m., on Lawns up to and including 5000 square feet; on Lawns over that amount, from five to eight-thirty o'clock p.m., and any person wishing to use the water on their Lawns or Gardens in the morning in place of the evening may do so between the hours of six and eight o'clock a.m., by giving notice to that effect in writing to the Secretary. It must, however, be clearly understood that the water cannot be used on Lawns or Grounds both morning and evening.
