(Continued from Page One) too large an amount in view of numerous other calls.

After much discussion it was finally agreed to fix on \$20,000, the council to be asked to vote \$10,000. Later a deputation composed of Mrs. Livingston, Mrs. Gordon Smith, Mrs. Schell, Mrs. George Watt, Messrs. W. F. Couch, M. F. Cook and E. L. Gould was named to wait on the Aldermen.

The length of the campaign was fixed at two weeks to end Nov. 4th and 5th.

The next requisite to the successful prosecution of the appeal to the citizens was considered to be a publicity committee. Following a motion made by Mr. J. H. Spence, and seconded by Mr. Gamble, Mr. F. D. Reville, Mr. T. H. Preston and Mr. E. L. Gould were appointed.

Inspector Kilmer was asked to cooperate with the principals of the different schools for the purpose of securing the aid of the school children, an important element of the population.

(Continued from page 1) the event of the adoption of the plan.

Some of the townships have assumed an attitude of opposition to the immediate scheme, preferring to delay the matter until the conclusion of the war. However, if the scheme were taken hold of the following reasons were suggested as recipients of the proposed improvements:

Township of Brantford The highway known as the Hamilton-Burford road, extending from Wentworth County on the east, to Oxford County on the west, nine miles of which would be in Brantford township; the Norwich road, leading south to the Oakland line, and the St. George road from the city to South Dufferin.

South Dufferin designated (by miles of the road leading from Paris on the west side of the river, north to the Galt road, also from Paris on the east side of the third concession, then easterly to St. George, continuing in that direction to Beverly Township, ending up with the Wentworth system and thus completing the highway from Brantford to the above mentioned road.

Burford suggested that part of the above mentioned stone road, running through the middle of the township, the Norwich road, leading south to the Oakland line, and the St. George road from there to New Dunham and the balance of the township allotment to be taken up by lateral roads running to the above two high ways.

Onondaga named the river road east from Middeport to the town line; and the Onondaga to the Brantford township boundary.

Oakland wanted improvements between that village and Scotland and the north to concession two and three east to the Mt. Pleasant road.

In some cases greater mileage was involved than was allotted to a particular township and when Mr. Horgan was consulted in this regard he stated that one hundred miles was the last two days sent for a report as the proper proportion of Brant.

The council then adjourned over the noon hour to enable a new allotment to be calculated on a hundred-mile basis for the count.
