

LOCAL AND OTHER ITEMS.

The Governor General of Canada has consented to formally open the Cape Breton Railway next month.

J. W. MacKay, the celebrated California millionaire, has been elected a director of the Canadian Pacific railway.

Four men, one white and three colored, were killed by a boiler explosion, twelve miles from Columbia, South Carolina, on the 14th.

A large exhibit of Spanish produce will be sent to the Toronto Exhibition and the Customs Department has been asked to allow them to enter duty free.

By a double haul at Colonia Springs, on the 14th, two persons were washed away and railroad tracks, houses, etc., were badly damaged as were the crops.

VEAR-GENERAL MACDONALD, of Alexandria, Ontario, has been appointed the 2nd Bishop of the see of Alexandria. The Archbishop of Kingston has received notification of the fact.

This time for reaching London for the fast Atlantic mail service operated on the 15th. Owing to Hon. Mr. Foster's absence from Ottawa it is not known how many have been put in.

A CALCUTTA dispatch of the 14th says: The Gangetic river has overflowed its banks and the surrounding country is inundated to an extent never before known. There is great loss of life.

A LONDON dispatch of the 18th says: During a heavy downpour of rain this morning at Holywell, tons of thousands of small frogs came tumbling to the ground and swarmed over the road.

The White Star steamship Tonic arrived at New York on the 19th, in 5 days, 19 hours and 55 minutes, from Queenstown, beating the best previous western passage of the City of Paris by 13 minutes.

RECENT floods in Bohemia have done enormous damage to property. Many persons were drowned. The Bohemian railway for a distance of six miles was swept away, and the great military road was destroyed.

DEPT. OF AGRICULTURE, Ottawa, has issued an excellent brochure prepared by Geo. Johnson, bearing on the resources of Jamaica and the West Indies. Commissioner Brown will distribute them with a view of waking up interest in the Jamaica Exhibition.

DURING a heavy storm that prevailed at Oxford, Germany, a few days ago, a house containing 20 inhabitants fell to the ground. Thirteen persons who were in the house were killed. Twenty others, more or less injured, were rescued, while 12 are still buried in the wreck.

A RECENT disastrous accident on the Northern Pacific at Drummond, Mont., was caused by a "sun kick" in the rails. Heat expanded the rails to such an extent that the spaces between them became entirely closed, and, there being no more room for expansion, the rails were bent and the ties and rails were thereby forced out of position.

CAPTAIN REEKE, of the steamer St. Paul, arrived at San Francisco, on the 14th, from Honolulu. He says Victoria sailed this year second fastest of any ship. In consequence the sale of the St. Paul American commercial company is greatly reduced. He believes that in five years the sale will become the same. He says George has just been made to order any of the large fleet of contraband vessels in Behring Sea.

HAMILTON, ONT., has lost its veritable "adopted inhabitant" by the death of Mr. Myler O'Reilly, Q. C., Master of the Supreme Court and ex-Judge of the District of Gore. Mr. O'Reilly was 85 years of age and had resided in Hamilton since 1830. He is said to have lived longer in Hamilton than any other person. He was the senior member of the bar in Ontario, and except Sir John Macdonald, the oldest Q. C. in the province.

The St. John Sun, of the 13th says: St. John Exhibition associations are on the verge of arrangements whereby the Island exhibitors will be allowed to withdraw their stock at an earlier date than provided for in the regulations in order to allow them to exhibit at other exhibitions. The present list of the first annual exhibition of Prince Edward Island to be held at Charlottetown on September 30th, and October 1, 2 and 3 has been received. It is a well-prepared list, and is a credit to the Island province.

The crew of the belted cruiser presented a petition to the Lords of Admiralty, at Portsmouth, England, on the 13th, complaining of unwarrantable cruelty toward them from the galling of lumber-dismantling. The petitioners are confined in cells situated as close to the boilers that when steam is got up the weakened men are nearly roasted to death. The commanding officers having refused to be heard by any competent authority, the men have had no choice but to prefer charges of wanton cruelty against them.

An excursion train from Atlantic City, on the Baltimore and Ohio railroad, was wrecked about 20 miles from Pittsburgh, Pa., on the 14th, by obstruction placed on the track. The engine was thrown over an embankment. The four cars ran along the rails a distance of 30 feet, and fell over on the other side of the track towards Hillside. John Sullivan, engineer of the train, Daniel Goodwin, riding in the cab, and a tramp, riding on the platform, were killed. If the cars had gone over the embankment into the river, the loss of life would have been frightful. Four ties had been placed across between and on the rails.
