Any person who is the sole head of a tamily, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manliobs, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son. danghter, brother or eister of intending homesteader.


In certain districts a bomesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter ection slongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre

Daties-Must reside upon the home stead or pre empfion six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required a homestead patent) and cultivate fify acres extra.

A homesteader who has oxhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain. a pre-emption may enter for a purchas. ed homestead in certain districts. Price \$'.90 per acre. Duties .- Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00. W. W. CORY.


