The conservatives and Sir John Macdonald are not so enthusiastic in their admiration for the judicial committee of the policy council as they were when they admirably styled them the supreme tribunal in the empire.

The Manitoba boundary, for in place of giving her a straight "due north" line from the northwest angle of the Lake of the Woods as her eastern boundary, which the Manitoba boundary act of 1881 gives her, the judicial committee have, without the authority of the imperial, dominion or provincial legislatures, run the eastern boundary of Manitoba partly due north and then eastward through the lakes and rivers north of Ontario to the meridian of the settlement of the Ohio and Mississippi.
