Biggest Irrigation Scheme.

The biggest irrigation project on the continent is that half completed in Alberta. It includes three great stretches of land termed the western, central and eastern blocks. In the western are 1,039,000 acres to be reclaimed; in the central are about a million and in the eastern are 1,150,224.

The western section is the nearest completed, and it alone forms a project as large as any in the United States, and the largest yet attempted in Canada.

Already there have been completed seventeen miles of main canal, 254 miles of secondary canals and 1,329 miles of distributing ditches.

The lands are being sold at from \$30 an acre up with a charge of 50 cents an acre per year for the water right.

Less than five per cent. of these lands in the western block remain unsold.

Now nearing completion a dam on the Bow river is 7,000 feet long, 350 feet wide at the base, and 45 feet high. From this dam canals will lead out over 500,000 acres of land.

Eight million dollars has been appropriated by the company to start the work on the eastern block, and preliminary surveys have been made for the central block. In five years or so a tract 30 miles wide and 150 miles long between Calgary and Moose Jaw will be irrigated and tens of thousands of farms will take the place of the wild prairies of to-day.
