"Nelson Day" Drive Has Great Object Appeal of the Navy League is Directed to all Classes of Citizens

Canadians all over the Dominion will remember how in September of last year the Navy League of Canada made an ap-peal for one Million dollars for the relief of the dependents of dead and injured seaman of the merchant marine who were the victims of the German submarine

the victims of the German submarine campaign.

It will be remembered how under the name of "Sailors' Week"—thanks to the thorough-going co-operation of the public with the workers—the campaign was a complete success and the objective was reached and passed.

The Navy League of Canada again appeals to all citizens for funds urgently required to carry on its work. The "Nelson Day" Campaign has been launched and on Oct. 21-22-23 the sum of \$500,000 will be raised by voluntary contribution. The money will be devoted to the payment of the debt of gratitude to the Canadian seamen lost in the war; to provide protection and home comfort for seaman who come to Canadian ports; to educate the people to the need of a strong navy and a strong mercantile marine and to native-born lads for service in the navy and Canadian merchant ships. All the money accruing from the "Nelson Day" campaign will be spent in Canada.
