Annual Report of the Minister of Finance for the Past Fiscal Year.

Ottawa, Dec. 26.—The annual report of the Minister of Finance for the past fiscal year, ending June 30, 1895, is published. The report shows that the revenue for the year ended in an increase of \$6,891,877, in the net public debt, which on June 30, stood at \$25,074,927. The report also shows that the total expenditure for the year was \$25,074,927, which is the same as the total revenue.
