

Agents, who are required by law to furnish all applicants with correct information as to what lands are open for sale.

The Government Emigration Agents at Quebec, Montreal, Ottawa, Kingston, Toronto, and Hamilton, will afford information and advice to emigrants respecting the best means of reaching the localities in which they intend to settle.

Instructions to Emigrants with some capital.

Emigrants with some capital, desirous of settling on land, and unaccustomed to life in the bush, would do well to purchase a Lot with a House, Outbuildings, and a few acres of clearance. Lots of this description are always to be found in the newly settled districts, the title to which is still in the Crown. In such cases a sum must be given for the right and improvements of the original purchaser. The patent would then be issued on payment of the balance of the purchase money due to the Crown, and on completion of the required settlement duties.

The Crown Land Agents will aid Emigrants inquiring for Improved Lots within their Agencies, for which patents have not been issued. They will say where such Lots are to be found, and they will assist, if requested, in drawing up the necessary assignment to the purchaser, for registration in the Department of Crown Lands.
