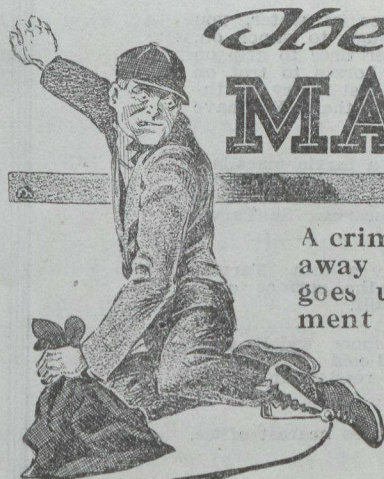

POLICE SIGNAL SYSTEM PROVES SUCCESSFUL

That the local police signal system is a most useful accessory to the local force, was proved recently when constable Gorman made his sensational capture of Edward J. O'Sullivan who was found guilty of pure swindling. At 11:45 P.M. A. in Canada, who was the victim of the theft, phoned to the police office giving a description of the man who had just taken her purse. Inside of three minutes this description had been phoned to every constable on beat. At 11 o'clock the man had been captured and was locked in the station cell.

All this through the signal system, which was installed in 1912 by the Northern Electric Co. It comprises twelve hanks at various points throughout the city. Each box is equipped with a telephone, a light and a bell.
