Given the facts that women did not begin to enter the FS Group in increased numbers until the mid-60 and that many left the service to marry, it will still be some time before there can be any marked improvement in their distribution among the levels in the group. While, in a reasonably stable situation it would be difficult to arrive at a realistic target for to overall participation rate of women there is still not sufficient infortion available on the possible numerical effects which will result from the consolidation of the foreign service. Preliminary indications are that distribution will still be concentrated at the lower levels and the participation rate will fall. There are two further complications. They are the proposed restructuring of the FS Group itse and the still unpredictable effect the introduction of the new management.
