

Explore Counter-Mine Procedures Experts Group

D1 The States parties undertake to discuss, in the context of a Verification Commission special session, the modalities of creating and operating a "Counter-Mine Procedures Experts Group." The objective of the Counter-Mine Experts Group would be to discuss and develop, on an ongoing basis, appropriate technologies and approaches for the humanitarian and cost-effective location and clearance of mines, [booby traps], [and other devices]. The States parties will consider the recommendations of the special session at the earliest opportunity but no later than the first review session of the Convention. Explore Mine Clearance School

E1 The States parties undertake to discuss, in the context of a Verification Commission special session, the modalities of creating and operating a "Mine Clearance School." The objective of the Mine Clearance School would be to provide specialized training in the location, clearance, and destruction of mines, [booby traps], [and other devices]. The Verification Commission special session would consider issues such as: funding, staffing, location, training approaches, and curriculum. States parties will consider the recommendations of the special session at the earliest opportunity but no later than the first review session of the Convention.

NON-INTERNATIONAL CONFLICT CONFIDENCE BUILDING ARRANGEMENT

The following text proposes confidence building measures focusing on concerns about the use of mines (booby-traps, and other devices) in non-international conflict situations.⁶

Voluntary Information

F1 States parties will consider, on a voluntary basis, submitting information about "mines of an unknown type" discovered during or after military activities. The information should be submitted to the Mine
