

ARTICLE XI

The Government of Bolivia shall grant Canadian personnel and their dependants immunity from seizure of their personal and official baggage.

ARTICLE XII

The Government of Bolivia shall exempt Canadian personnel and their dependants from the obligation to register as aliens and from immigration restrictions.

ARTICLE XIII

The Government of Bolivia shall guarantee to Canadian personnel and all their dependants facilities for free travel throughout Bolivian territory and travel into and out of the country.

ARTICLE XIV

The Government of Bolivia shall provide:

- (a) all permits, licences and other documents required by Canadian firms and Canadian personnel in the performance of their duties in Bolivia; and
- (b) export permits and exit visas, as the case may be, for Canadian personnel and their dependants and for materials, professional and technical equipment and the personal effects of this personnel.

ARTICLE XV

Any differences which may arise in the application of the provisions of this Agreement or a subsidiary arrangement shall be settled by negotiations between the Government of Canada and the Government of Bolivia or in any other manner mutually acceptable to the Contracting Parties to this Agreement.

ARTICLE XVI

This Agreement shall be effective on the date it is signed by the two Contracting Parties and shall remain effective as long as one Contracting Party or the other has not terminated it by six (6) months' notice in writing. However, such termination shall not void the contracts already entered into and the guarantees already given under this Agreement.
