A. (1) Diplomatic representatives and officials of Canada accredited in Italy to Italy as well as members of their families and staff who hold diplomatic special or service passports may obtain multiple entry visas valid for an unlimited number of entries to or departures from Italy during the appointment of the representatives and officials concerned in that country or for the period of validity of their passports whichever is the lesser.

(2) Diplomatic representatives and officials of Italy accredited in Canada as well as members of their families and staff who hold diplomatic special or service passports may obtain multiple entry visas valid for an unlimited number of entries to or departures from Canada during the appointment of the representatives and officials concerned in that country or for the period of validity of their passports whichever is the lesser.

B. (1) Italian citizens who are born the non-immigrants coming to Canada and who are in possession of valid national passports will receive with a minimum of delay from the competent Canadian authorities or consular authorities in Italy visas free of charge, valid for an unlimited number of entries into Canada during a period of twelve months from the date of issue of such visas.
