The Canadian Embassy avails itself of this opportunity to convey to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs the assurance of its highest consideration for the compensation for war damage to property in Canada.

Canadian Government to French and Canadian nationals who were responsible to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for equal treatment shall be extended to the French nationals for loss of the same nature and extent for the property damaged in the war a compensation equivalent to that granted to the French Government will be granted to Canadian nationals whose property in France was damaged in the war a compensation equivalent to that granted to the French Government. Ministry of Foreign Affairs and basing thereon the Technical Agreement.
