PRAYERS.

A Message was received from the Senate informing this House that the Senate had agreed to the consequential amendments made by the House of Commons to the amendment made by the Senate to the Bill No. 32, An Act respecting the Ottawa and New York Railway Company, without amendment.

Also,—A Message informing this House that the Senate had agreed to the amendment made by the House of Commons to the Bill No. 81 (Letter C2 of the Senate), intituled: "An Act to amend the Winding-up Act," without amendment.

Also,—A Message informing this House that the Senate had agreed to the amendments made by the House of Commons to the Bill No. 66 (Letter E1 of the Senate), intituled: "An Act respecting the Department of Insurance," without amendment.

And also,—A Message informing this House that the Senate had passed the Bill No. 92, An Act to amend the Income War Tax Act, with amendments, which are as follows:—

1. Page 1, line 10. For the words "the members" substitute "commissioned officers".
2. Page 1, line 12. Leave out the words "other than enlisted men".
3. Page 1, line 13. After the word "salaries" insert "or pay".
4. Page 1, line 16. After the word "salaries" insert "or pay".
5. Page 1, line 20. Add the following as a proviso to subsection (2) of section 9A:—

"Provided that in the case of persons appointed during the fiscal year, the tax shall be payable in equal monthly instalments on the last day of each month."
