PRAYERS.

The Clerk of the House laid on the Table the following Private Bill:—

Bill No. 8, An Act respecting The Quebec Railway, Light and Power Company.—*Mr. Parent (Quebec West and South)*.

The said Bill was read the first time, and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House, pursuant to Standing Order 102.

Mr. Dunning, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House, —Statement of the Superintendent of Insurance concerning the operations of the Civil Service Insurance Act for the year ended March 31, 1938, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 23, Section 21, R.S.C. 1927.

Mr. Power, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House,—Copy of Order in Council, P.C. 113, dated January 17, 1939, amending regulations made by Order in Council, P.C. 91, dated January 16, 1936: granting additional hospital allowances to members of the forces in receipt of pensions for amputations and certain other disabilities for which appliances must be worn which cause wear and tear on clothing worn by them.—(Pensions and National Health Act, Chapter 39, 18-19 George V.)

Mr. Cahan, seconded by Mr. Anderson, by leave of the House, introduced a Bill, No. 9, An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, which was read the first time, and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.
