All mominations for this office shall be sent in writing to the Secretary of the Protestant Committee and forwarded by him to the members of the Protestant Committee a reasonable time prior to the date fixed for the election. There shall also be a joint board for school leaving and matriculation examinations and the membership of this board shall be as follows:a. The Director of Protestant Education for the Province b. The Professor of Education, McGill University c. The Professor of Education, Bishop's University d. The Dean of the School for Teachers, Macdonald College and five other members to be chosen at large by the Protestant Committee. The five members to be chosen at large shall be selected from recognized authorities or teachers of the following subjects respectively:-1. Greek and Latin 2. Moderns 3. Mathematics and Physics 4. Chemistry 5. Biology and the ex officio members above mentioned shall be responsible for the duties of the board in relation to all other subjects. It shall be the duty of this board to revise carefully the composition of all examination papers set by the examiners, and the examiners and members of the board should be guided as near as can be by the following rules:a. The board should not substantially change the composition of any examination paper without consulting the examiner. b. All members of the University staff on the panel of examiners have the privilege of consulting their University departments on the composition of the examination papers they prepare. c. The examiners should wherever possible consult a member or members of
