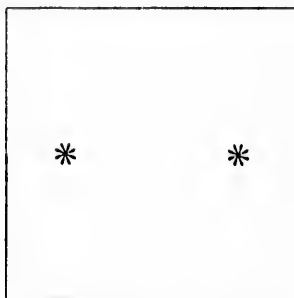


joined by a rigid top cross-bar. The poles must be fitted with a cone-shaped netting of not more than one and one-half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) inches mesh, which cone shall extend and be fastened to a stake in the ground at a point seven feet back of the centre of the goal; and said netting shall be so made as to prevent the passage of the ball put through the goal from the front, and the bottom of the netting must be held close to the ground with tent-pegs or staples. They shall be placed at least 110 yards (and if the grounds will permit, 125 yards) from each other. In matches they must be furnished by the home club.

SEC. 2. The goal-crease shall be a marked line, twelve feet square, and the flag-poles shall be placed six feet from the front and back lines, and three feet from the side lines.



RULE IV.

THE TEAMS.

SEC. 1. Twelve players and a captain shall constitute a full team; they shall be regular members in good standing of the club they represent, and no other (except it be a club in connection with a university, college or school), for at least twenty-one days before being eligible to play in a match for their club, and must be *bona fide* residents of the city. Players shall not be allowed to change clubs more than once during the season: and twenty-one days' notice shall be given to the secretary-treasurer of the Association by the player making the change, said
